

As we look forward to the summer months I hope that you will find time to rest and relax over the holiday period.

Maybe you will be looking for some holiday reading - what about taking a fresh look at some familiar tales - some of which you will have known since your childhood?

I'm suggesting that you spend August looking at the Book of Genesis. This is the first book in the Bible and contains the stories of creation, Adam and Eve, Cain and Abel, the Tower of Babel, Noah, Abraham and Sarah, Isaac and Jacob, Joseph and his famous coat.

As you read the book I pray that you will gain a deeper appreciation of the stories that were passed on by people as they tried to discover what it meant to be created, and called, and blessed by God.

When Jesus walked with his followers on the way to Emmaus he 'opened' the scriptures to them, starting with the 'Books of Moses' and their hearts burned within them as he spoke.

In other words he started to explain everything to them by delving into the stories that started in Genesis - may our hearts burn within us as we explore these texts this summer.

Study guides will be available in all of our churches, and many of our services will follow this teaching theme.
